



There might be a dust storm.

It's hot and sunny.






The countries should work together to save the Earth.


It's the book fair today. Can I buy a book?

Yes, of course. But you must buy a good book.




Some books were too easy. Some books were scary.

There is a new shopping centre near the airport.




Where's the treasure? How do I get there?

The treasure is in the north of the garden.










Compass is an Arab invention.

Young children have twenty baby teeth.


If you eat too many sweets, you will have bad teeth.

Is Sara good at running? Yes, she is.






